We have:

- Lobbied for adoption by St Edmundsbury Borough Council of a Cumulative Impact Policy with agreement to maintain that status. Therefore any new licensing applicant has to prove that the granting of a licence to sell alcohol will not increase antisocial behaviour in the town
- Increased the number of residents' parking bays, and are trying to provide more
- Campaigned to reduce noise from licensed premises
- Liaised closely with the police on petty vandalism, parking and traffic matters
- Raised objections to building developments which would have threatened the special character of the area
- Campaigned for and achieved high speed broadband across the area
- Persisted with, and campaigned for, the introduction of Civil Parking Enforcement.
